Candidate Seeks To End One-Party System, Lack Of Responsiveness To Constituents, And Unnecessary Taxes

Randolph, NJ – September 08, 2011 - A special meeting of the Randolph Democratic Committee (RDC) was held on September 8th at Randolph Township Library where attendees crowded in to hear Randolph Town Council candidate Dr. Jay Sweifach share his visions for Randolph's future, as he was selected the Democratic Party nominee for the vacant Randolph Town Council seat.

His professional life began as a social worker for the Jewish Community Centers of MetroWest in West Orange and Whippany, where he was youth services director for 10 years. Currently an Associate Professor at the Wurzweiler School of Social Work, he teaches philosophy, ethics, diversity, and group work. He is a licensed clinical social worker, working with a practice in Hackettstown as a psychotherapist, and leads a klezmer band called the Hester Street Troupe.

Jay and his family are committed to Randolph.... a special community where rich history, beautiful surroundings, excellent schools, amenities, ambiance, and opportunities abound. His vision for Randolph is to allow citizens to have a voice in expressing preferences, priorities, and demands, and he is interested in creating a process where residents can provide input *before* decisions are made. Five years ago, he conducted a survey to solicit Randolph resident opinions and concerns, as he believes that residents know best what is needed and ought to be asked their opinion -- he plans to launch a second survey to take the current pulse of Randolph residents. He believes in an open, transparent government where partisan interest and special interest is replaced with the interests of residents.
